



Beautiful natural habitats and murals

Natureworks created accurate representations of four main habitats of the Ipswich local area – Eucalypt, Sclerophyll, Bloodwoods and Tea tree – complete with wildlife common to these habitats.

Using museum techniques, the team combined artificial trees, rocks, foliage and highly realistic wildlife sculptures to recreate the natural environment. The habitats were fixed into cement to reduce unauthorised removal. Colourful murals and sound activated speakers completed the effect, merging 2D and 3D art for a memorable experience.
